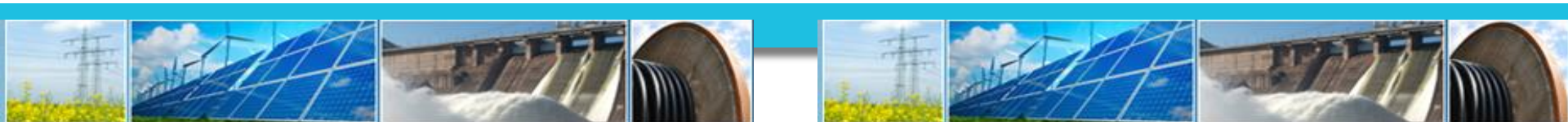

The Alliance leads the industry in enhancing and promoting supply chain sustainable practices across utilities and suppliers



## *How we measure and show progress - Updated*

**Mission:** The Alliance activities aim to improve the sustainability of the products and services utilities buy and use, as well as the performance of suppliers and supply chain operations. This will be done by:

- Partnering with stakeholders and value chain partners to identify, promote and adopt successful sustainability practices;
- Fostering the availability of and demand for more sustainable solutions; and
- Delivering tangible business value to the industry through the application of sustainability practices.

**Guiding Principles:** Independence, Openness, Inclusivity, Voluntary, Consensus-based decisions, Sustainability, Membership Driven, Incorporate Best Practices, Broad Applicability, Environmental and Social Sustainability



- **Member Focused Goals**

1. Each member will improve by one maturity level in three attributes of the Utility Framework
2. 75% of members will adopt and document the benefits from at least three new supply chain sustainability practices
3. The Alliance will develop a knowledge sharing platform to capture, manage, and transfer successful practice

- **Supplier Focused Goals**

4. 100% of members will participate and use the results of the Supplier Survey to engage high impact suppliers on sustainability improvements
5. The Alliance will initiate a Supplier Affiliate Membership program with at least 75 members and establish a Supplier Advisory Board
6. The Alliance will continually release materials (at least 6 per year) to educate suppliers (e.g., practices sharing sessions, newsletter)

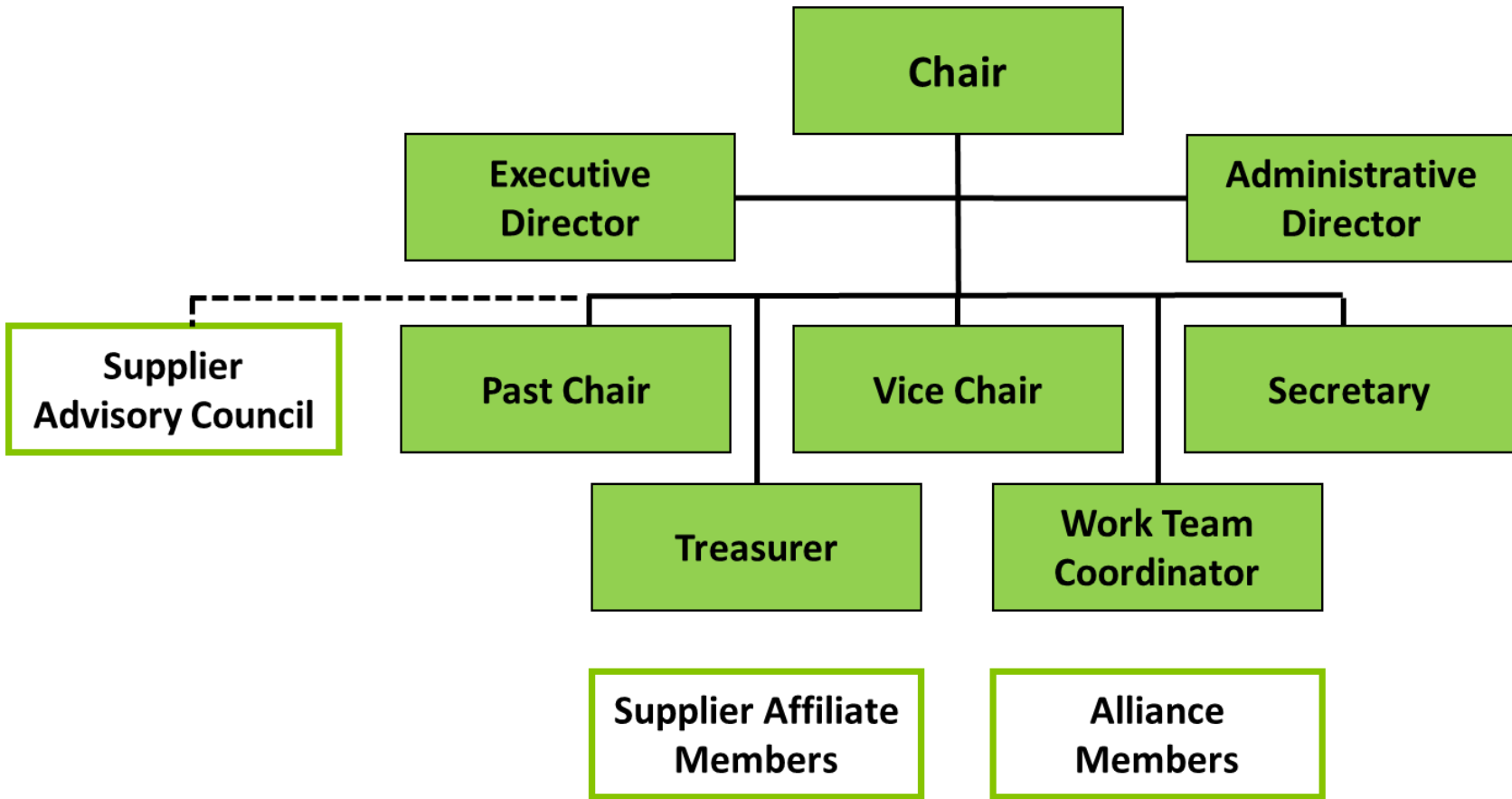


- **Alliance Focused Goals**

7. The Alliance will host at least 3 Alliance member roadshows to drive membership recruitment and/or engagement through 2020
8. There will be 10000 website views of Alliance developed work products
9. The Alliance will complete its transition from an SDO to a Trade Association



## *How we work as a group*



**Proposed Update:** Alliance membership is open to all non-competitive electric and gas utilities, which own and operate a reasonably sized transmission and/or distribution infrastructure, report to a utility governing body and deliver power to over 100 individual customers.
